Proposed Bylaw No. 24/2011

The Council of the City of Yorkton, pursuant to Section 207 of The Planning and Development Act, 2007, hereby gives notice of its intention to pass Bylaw No. 24/2011, which is an amendment to City of Yorkton Zoning Bylaw No. 14/2003 to rezone Lots 16, 17 and the southerly 6.1 metres (20 feet) of Lot 18 in Block 3, Plan 101961525 (on the northwest corner of Balmoral Street and Seventh Avenue North) from R-5 Mixed Density Residential to R-3 Medium Density Residential.

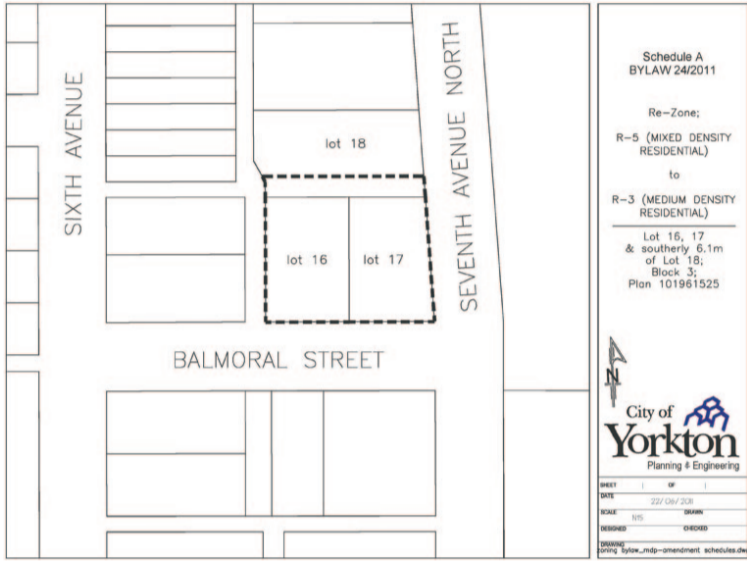
The purpose of the proposed bylaw is to increase the maximum building height from 2.5 to 4 storeys, and permit the proposed use of a 3-storey Apartment dwelling.

The proposed Zoning Bylaw Amendment may be inspected in the office of the Planning and Engineering Department, City Hall by any person without payment of any fees between the hours of 9:00 a.m. and 4:00 p.m., all holidays excepted and up **until 12:00 noon on Friday, July 8, 2011.**

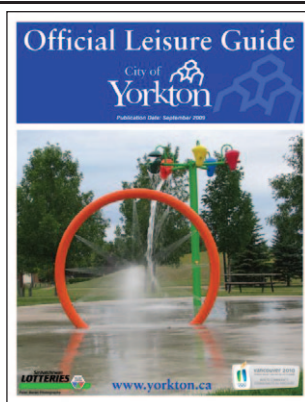
